Frank's Trap Report: As of November 30th, the league took in \$1757.00 of which \$1581.30 was deposited in the Trap Fund and \$175.70 was deposited into the Trap Equipment Fund. This resulted in an estimated "profit" of about \$738 to the club. Shooting for the season averaged 14 rounds per week. The 1757.00 taken in by the league represented a 41% increase versus 2020 and a 47% increase over last year. This increase is mostly due to adopting a straight \$4 cost per round versus the sliding cost schedule used for the previous two years. Good weather also contributed with only one day (August 17th) lost due to rain. There was also one additional day (November 2nd) added to the schedule. Response to the newly installed Pat Trap has been extremely positive. It broke far fewer birds than the retired 1950's Winchester Western trap. By being set to throw the proper angle ATA targets it also resulted in significantly more perfect rounds than shot in previous years. This season we had:

- 50 Consecutive birds Steve Smith (1 round)
- 25 Consecutive birds Mike Galusha (6 rounds), Jerry Seyboth (5 rounds), Frank Fuss (2 rounds), and Steve Smith (1 round)

Please plan to attend our annual New Year's Day shoot at 12 pm on Sunday, January 1, 2023, and our President's Day shoot at 12 pm on Sunday, February 19, 2023.


PLEASE stop bringing cardboard and other items that are being left on the property, mostly the outdoor range area. We know that intentions are good, but it creates more work as we must


